What is the Glenview Blades Parent Advisory Board?

The Glenview Blades Parent Advisory Board is a Certified Support Group of the Glenview Park District that supports the synchronized skating team activities at the Glenview Ice Center.

Duties:

- Facilitate communication between the Ice Center, the coaches and the parents
 - Monthly Board meetings with Ice Center personnel and coaches
 - Monthly Parent meetings to provide team information and answer questions from families
- Helping the coaches organize Glenview Blades activities:
 - Help organize team events, including social activities, a Skating Sister program, and out of town trips
 - Providing information about synchronized skating, USFSA, competitions, etc. for parents and families
 - Organizing Practice Attire, Outerwear, Costume, and possibly Pin and T-Shirts, orders and payments
- <u>Fundraising</u>—Park District fees cover the coaches' salaries and weekly ice time.

 <u>Blades Board covers:</u> 1) Competition fees; 2) Half the cost of competition dresses; 3) Extra Ice time as needed; 4) Team t-shirts, when ordered; 5) Coaches' hotel rooms at overnight competitions; 6) Team events and parties.

Fundraising includes:

- Ice Center Resale (Blades gets a percentage of sales)
- Selling ads, Friendship Squares, Flower and Programs at the Ice Show
- Arranging for Vendors and Flower sales at the Freeze and Chicago Open competitions (Blades gets a percentage of Vendor sales)
- Scrip program—A voluntary store rebate program that earns money for Blades and families
- One mandatory fundraiser (TBD)
- Supporting the Ice Center in return for reduced program fees:
 - o Providing volunteers for the Freeze and Chicago Open Competitions
 - Organizing the Ice Center Equipment Resale
 - Organizing, Laying out, & Printing the Ice Show Program in return for Ad and program sales money

• Publicizing the Glenview Blades Organization:

- Providing photographs and information as needed for Park District Marketing efforts.
